English proficiency and placement test

You will not have to complete a placement test on arrival if:

- ▶ You submit results for a recognised proficiency test and achieved an overall IELTS of 5.0 or equivalent.
- ▶ Your proficiency test was taken within two years before your course commencement date.
- ▶ If you do not have a proficiency test score, you will be asked to do a placement test when you arrive on campus and to be placed into the appropriate level of the course.
- ▶ If you do not meet the required entry proficiency you will first be placed into the General English program to allow you to reach the required English proficiency level to enter the Academic program.

IELTS (International English Language Testing System) is the standard test used for university entry in Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Britain and much of the USA. An IELTS score is often a requirement of the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) of Australia for migration purposes.

The IELTS Preparation course can help you to achieve a higher score in the official IELTS test and gain entry to the pathway of your choice while developing your overall English skills.


- ❖ Amazing outdoor lifestyle with walking and cycle paths to explore the Harbour, parks and gardens.


